REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

Paulding County Commissioners requests qualification statements and proposals from non-profit agencies to perform necessary functions for its PY2026 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Community Development Program, including: Community Development Block Grant Program – Allocation; Allocation Planning; FLEX – Downtown; FLEX –Economic Development; Critical Infrastructure, Neighborhood Revitalization; Economic Development Program – Loan Program; Public Infrastructure Grants: Revolving Loan Fund; Residential Public Infrastructure Program; Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program– in partnership with the City of Defiance and Defiance County; General Program Income and any programs funded with CDBG, HOME or Ohio Housing Trust Fund (OHTF) programs. Scope of work includes development of grant applications, environmental review records, fair housing program, technical assistance for grant activities, and any related CDBG/RLF planning work. Paulding County is seeking services and will follow the competitive negotiation method of procurement as provided in 24 CFR Part 85. Under this method, the County will receive qualifications and proposals from interested service offerors until the designated date and time listed below.

This notice shall serve as our Request for Proposal (RFP) for services. Response to this RFP will be used to select a qualified non-profit to perform the required grant writing and administrative assistance needed by Paulding County.

Selection of an agency will proceed in the following manner:

1. Paulding County will review and evaluate the RFP filed by the deadline. Evaluation criteria include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Specialized experience or technical expertise of the firm and its personnel in connection with CDBG and other economic and community development services to be provided.
 - b. Past record of performance on contracts with Paulding County including quality of work, timeliness, and cost control.
 - c. Capacity of firm to perform the work within time limitation, taking into consideration the current and planned workload of the firm.

- d. Familiarity of the firm with the type of problems applicable to the requested services.
 - e. Experience working on CDBG, RLF, economic development, housing or other similar projects involving federal funds.
 - f. Familiarity and experience with Paulding County and its neighborhoods.
2. Negotiations for a contract will begin with the top candidate selected. If negotiations are not successful, the process will begin again with the candidate rated second, and so on.
3. Upon completion of successful negotiations, a contract will be executed with Paulding County.

Interested non-profit agencies should provide Paulding County with the following information:

- 1. A detailed listing of the scope of services that will be provided.
- 2. A brief 1-2-page description of the qualifications of personnel who will be doing the work, their experience in and familiarity with Paulding County, and familiarity with the CDBG programs.
- 3. Location of the agencies' office and number of hours/days per week which will be devoted to the County's CDBG program.
- 4. A statement of the hourly billing rates for all personnel.
